Population Cancer Screening

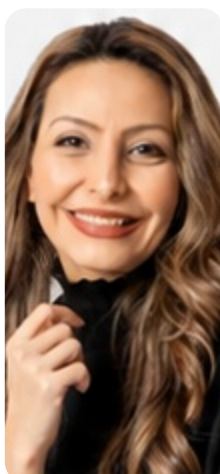
A/Prof Homi Zargar, Dr Saam Tourani, Dr Affie Tourani and Dr Arun Gupta

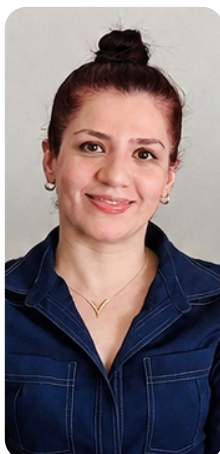
Vulvovaginal Disease

Biologics in Psoriasis: Who Should Be Referred Early?

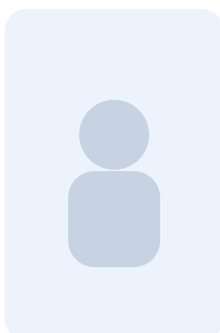
Dr Ritva Vyas
